# Call for Research: Nature loss and the economy in Latin America

General FAQ

## **When is the deadline to submit research proposals?**

The deadline for submitting proposals is 23:59 BST on Wednesday, 12 February 2025.

## **Can I submit proposals that do not directly address any of CETEX's research priorities?**

CETEX's December 2024 call for proposal targets one specific research area, namely on the implications of nature-loss, deforestation and land-use change on macroeconomic stability, in the regional context of Latin America. Proposals should target the field of research that is outlined in the Call for Proposals document and stress their contribution and relevance to the work of monetary and financial market authorities.

## **What is the size of grants CETEX seeks to award?**

In this targeted call, CETEX aims to support projects with an individual budget of approximately \$15,000 to \$35,000.

## **Who can submit proposals?**

This call is open to all institutions conducting research, with a particular focus on the regional context of Latin America and on researchers at academic institutions, non-profit organisations, NGOs, and international financial and monetary institutions. All funded research will have to become publicly available. Where proposals originate from outside Latin America, we strongly encourage collaboration between institutions, particularly with Latin American research or policy institutions.

## **When will I hear back whether my submission was successful or not?**

CETEX aims to give feedback on submissions in late February 2025.

## **How does the review process work?**

After submission, a group of reviewers will assess the overall quality, policy-relevance and research methodology of the proposals and select successful applicants. In case of an unsuccessful application, CETEX will try to give feedback to encourage further contributions to potential future calls for research.
